



Performing Team & Ensemble Requirements

Just B Dance Performing Teams are a select group of dancers interested in performing often and learning to choreograph. Performing Team is a privilege, and students invited to participate are expected to be a good role model to other students in our studio. Senior members (age 15+) will also be eligible to teach beginning level classes, and **all Performing Team members 11 years or older are eligible to assist classes.**

MINI Performing Team

- 1 ballet class level 1
- 1 jazz class level 1

Jr Performing Team

- 1 ballet class level 1 or higher
- 1 jazz class level 1 or higher
- 1 additional class of your choice (tap, hip hop, modern, etc)

Teen Performing Team

- 1 ballet classes
- 1 jazz class level 2 or higher
- 1 additional class of your choice. (tap, hip hop, modern, etc)

SR Performing Team

- 1 ballet classes
- 1 jazz class level 2 or higher
- 1 additional class of your choice. (tap, hip hop, modern, etc)

Jr Ensemble (GDA program)

- 2 ballet classes level 2 or higher
- 1 modern class level 2 or higher
- jazz class HIGHLY recommended

SR Ensemble (GDA program)

- 2 ballet classes level 4 or higher
- 1 modern class level 4 or higher
- 1 jazz class level 4 or higher

All Performing Teams POLICIES

- Set a good example by arriving to *all* classes on time and in uniform.
- Always be ready to give their best in class and rehearsals.
- Be willing to help teachers and students when needed.
- Costumes for small groups (SR ensemble only) will be assembled by the students in addition to their purchased costume (if necessary)
- **Attendance: All Performing Team members must not miss more than 2 Team classes September-December and no more than 4 classes January-May, always attending the 2 weeks prior to a performance. If you miss more than the allowed amount, you will be placed on probation until further notice.**
- Be available for all events on Calendar and if missing, let Ms. B know ASAP and does not exceed more than 1 event.
- **Mandatory to participate in 2017 "Believe" show December 15th-16th, our new Polar Express production!** The rehearsals will be during Team Rehearsals and if you would

like to do additional roles, the rehearsals will be on the weekend. All normal show fees apply. *This is for ALL TEAMS/ENSEMBLE*

- **PLEASE NOTE:** Just B team students not enrolled in all classes for their ballet level will not be eligible to perform with their ballet class.

Benefits

- Members get the opportunity to perform more often, including outreaches to rest homes and community events as well as local dance festivals.
- Senior members will be given opportunities to choreograph and all members will perform in small groups.
- Students learn basics of choreography, to apply when they are ready to begin choreographing.
- Performing Team member receives a 5% discount on their tuition!

Performing Team fees 2017-2018

In order to better prepare our families for the expenses associated with Team and to help the Studio cover costs, we are adding a Performing Team performance fee for all teams.

These fees cover:

- 1 costume
- Performance fees the studio pays for outside performances, such as:
 - Winter & Spring Showcase
 - Carol of Lights
 - Any other festivals we can participate in
 - Potential guest teacher opportunities
 - Holiday Show participation fee (\$100)
 - Holiday Show costume rental (\$75)
